# THE CHURCH IS NOT CLOSED...

- The Church has never been closed; it's always been open!
- We've added a church service.
- Our Kids ministry is now online and in homes.
- Families are worshipping together Saturday night and all day on Sundays.
- Community Groups (CGs) have gone online and CG leaders are leading in new ways.
- 50+ people have already signed up for our **Online Weekender** and are taking their next steps toward connection and community at Two Cities.
- Our church has continued to be **generous**.
- We've been able to deepen and extend our reach in this season online.

# **BUT IT'S NOT THE SAME.**

- Our staff and elders have been thinking about what would be the wisest, most careful, and at the same time, most aggressive way to get our church back together.
- It's a complex reality because of:
  - limited building and parking space on campus were already creating unique challenges before Covid-19
  - $\circ\,$  the size and scope of our church
    - **1500 people** on this campus on a Sunday
    - 250 kids you can't do Kids ministry social distancing
  - social distancing makes it hard to have dynamic worship and a hospitable environment to welcome new people.
- We're continuing to ask some questions, but we've put together a four phased plan.
  - At each phase, things become a less clear. You can view the plan as a progression:
    - Phase 1 a promise
    - Phase 2 a plan
    - Phase 3 a probability
    - Phase 4 a possibility



# THE FUTURE MAY BE BLURRY...

- We live in such a divided country right now. Things feel polarizing and political.
- This is not a political plan or a polarizing plan.
- This is a plan to bring clarity because where there is clarity there can be unity.
- Please pray for and pursue the unity of our church in this season.
- We know much of this plan might change.
- We are going to come back to you and over-communicate during each of these four phases as things change and develop.
- We are continuing to seek wise counsel from national church leaders in all of our decision making.
